



1. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE RACE

- In the race can participate persons who meet all the conditions laid down in this Regulation , or additional requirements set by the organizers .
- All competitors before the race must be reported to the organizer , and when the application must enable the organizer to determine their identity and any other necessary information .
- Competitors younger than 18 must also submit a written consent of the parents to participate in the trekking race .
- Competitors younger than 18 can not submit to the adventure races
- All competitors compete at their own risk .

2. COMPETITORS OBLIGATIONS

- From the beginning to end of the race competitors must wear start numbers assigned by the organizer . Start numbers must be visible throughout the race .
- The competitors themselves have to take care of food and drink for the duration of the race . Beyond that, the organizer leaves the possibility of forming refreshment station/s
- Competitors may not receive help from others , unless the organizer is not decide otherwise
- Competitors must behave in accordance with the Law on Road Traffic Safety . For each found violation of the said Act competitor will be penalized with one penalty clock that will be added to the total competitor time at the finish . The competitor that expensive 3 hour penalty for violation of the said Act , be excluded from the race.

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANIZER

- The organizer procures the necessary maps of the race.
- The organizer will provide transport bikes to the start of cycling stage races and for delivery back to the finish line after completing the cycling leg . The bike has to be labeled with starting number that is assigned by the organizer. The obligation of competitors is to protect his bike with suitable equipment , because the organizer does not take responsibility for any damage caused to the bicycle during transport .
- If any of the competitors get lost during the race , the organizer shall take measures to ensure that they return on the finish line or provide the instructions for further competition.



- Members of the organization and monitoring of the race, may, in its sole discretion, in the need to remove or cancel of checkpoints move or cancel checkpoint in a way that will not damage or missed any competitor .

4. RULES

General Informations

Adventure race is a team race (Ultra and Light length category). In adventure races the first three teams are rewarded in the overall and female / mix category.

- Prizes will be awarded for the top three places in the category, if at least 3 teams/competitors are competing in category.
- The final ranking of competitors will be determined according to the following criteria: - -
 - The highest number of actual control points,
 - Total time achieved with all penalty minutes.
- Competitors must respect the order of the control points, unless the organizer decided otherwise.
- Competitors within the teams are required to move together on the race and not be separated more than 100 meters apart, except on the sections where the organizer expressly permitted or where it is an integral part of the discipline.
- The race has banned any form of technical doping, motor transport, etc..
- Competitors are required to carry their garbage during the race and place it in a suitable location.
- A competitor who arrives at the checkpoint after the time limit, withdrawal or exclusion from the race, should continue according to the instructions of the organizers (shortcut or return to the finish line)
- If any competitor does not want or can not make the climb or descent by rope or jump into the water with the proper level, it is considered that did not pass the checkpoint and will either be penalized with a time penalty or be automatically overall included behind competitors who perform the indicated task.
- If a doctor or official person (organizer, head of competition, mountain rescuers...) finds that the competitor is hurt or disabled to continue racing, will be excluded from the race.



Mandatory equipment

- Competitors must have a mandatory personal and team equipment for every stage/disciplines prescribed by the organizer . The organizer reserves the right to check the content of the mandatory personal equipment of any competitor at any time of the race.
- If a player wants to make the climb or descent on the rope (or any other technical discipline) without the proper equipment , the competitor shall be disqualified from the race .
- For each missing part of prescribed equipment, competitors will be added 15 minutes of penalty .
- Competitors are responsible for damaged or lost equipment provided by the organizer and obliged to compensate the damage to the organizer .
- The organizer is not responsible for personal competitors equipment which are damaged or lost by themselves.

Conditions for disqualification of a competitor

- All competitors must comply strictly with the rules, otherwise they will be excluded from competition or punished with appropriate time penalty in accordance with the assessment of the organizer.
- For any misconduct, destruction of the environment or equipment (by organizer equipment or by equipment of other competitors), the competitor will be excluded from the race. Competitors are for their behavior, during the race, criminally, materially and morally responsible under the applicable law in the Republic of Croatia.

• Complaints

Competitors must submit appeals to the organizer in writing form no later than 15 minutes after the publication of unofficial results of the race. Complaints submitted after the deadline will not be accepted even if they are justified. Official results are final.

4. FINAL REGULATIONS

- The right of interpretation of this regulation have the organizer.
- Competitors agree that the entire video and photographic material will be use in the media with the purpose of promoting the race.
- Sponsors are allowed to advertise on the entire personal equipment of the competitors, except on areas allocated start number (chest and back, helmet and bike). As well is prohibited for the sponzors advertising on other competitors equipment which procures organizer (boats, paddles, life jackets ...).
- The race organizer reserves the right to change the rules. For all modifications the competitors will be timely informed on our website or at a briefing before the race.
